Pocket BMX 2D iPhone BMX Game Released On AppStore.

Pocket BMX is a new **2D BMX bike riding iPhone game** that puts the player in the shoes of a small, helmet wearing rider, in a quest to save the town. With the help of a mysterious mentor called the BMX Ninja, the player must **complete various challenges** and **collect certain items** throughout the levels. Play through the **7 different locations** on offer, learning **over 18 real world tricks** like the “tail-whip”, “back-flip”, “bar-spin”, “decade” and many more. There is also have the ability to combine these tricks to create an **endless amount of different combos**. All these skills will be needed to compete in the BMX Cup competition, where the player’s “runs” will be judged based on certain criteria.
